Art Exhibit Procedures

Eligibility - Art display shall be open to all artists of the visual arts with preference given to artists within the CSRA.

Requirements - All art exhibited within the AHC shall receive approval from the AHC Art Jury Committee prior to being considered for exhibit by the AHC Exhibit Committee. Exhibited art shall be original and shall have been completed within the past three (3) years.

Fees - If accepted as a juried artist (and the \$25 application fee has been paid), artists are required to maintain an annual membership with the AHC (memberships start at \$30) in order to display in the gift shop and participate in exhibits.

Jury Process - Submissions for judging shall be submitted as digital images on CD or flash drive or photos. Submissions should be fully representative of the work to be displayed. Artists approved by the Art Jury Committee for exhibition in the AHC shall be notified in writing. Approval for display does not in and of itself authorize a display. The AHC Exhibits Committee shall be responsible for the selection and schedule of displays. Submissions not selected may be returned if a self-addressed stamped envelope has been provided. Accepted submissions will be retained until after conclusion of display and may be used for advertising purposes without compensation to the artist.

Display - Prior to or in conjunction with the delivery of actual items for display to the AHC, the artist shall submit a full inventory with the fair market value of each piece. All art shall be ready for hanging or other appropriate method of display. Artists may use AHC equipment if it is available, or may supply their own suitable display equipment or furniture subject to approval by the AHC Director. All hangings shall be performed by and/or under the supervision of the AHC staff. Artists are responsible for any bios and display literature as needed. The Art Jury Committee shall have the right to disallow any one or several pieces of art for display even though the artist's work in general has been approved.

Insurance - The AHC carries insurance on items "owned by others" with a \$500.00 deductible. Artists are encouraged to carry additional insurance as needed.

Sales - The artist shall set the pricing on any item that is for sale. All items on exhibit that are sold shall be marked "Sold" and shall remain on display until the conclusion of the exhibit. In addition to the original works on exhibit, the artist may also sell originals or prints of work not included in the exhibit, either from the exhibit or from the gift shop (subject to approval of the Gift Shop Committee). The artist will be paid 70% commission and the AHC will receive 30%.

Gift Shop – If not juried specifically for gift shop and gallery, artist may bring artwork to the gift shop for sale however, all artwork will be considered individually based on storage space, seasonal emphasis, Arts & Heritage Center special events, exhibits, and the gift shop market.

Decisions and Appeals - All decisions of the Art Jury Committee shall be submitted to the AHC Executive Committee for approval. Appeals shall be submitted to the AHC Executive Committee.

Applications – Photographs or CDs/flash drive of items to be considered should be brought to the AHC Monday through Friday between 10am to 4pm. Once accepted, the artist is required to complete the Consignment Form for gift shop vendors.

Sales – The artist will be paid 70% commission and the AHC will receive 30%.
